Home Repair and Preservation Program

Our home repair work includes minor and critical repairs, from painting, yard cleanup and weatherization to electrical. This year we installed a roof, built ramps, installed handrails, and helped someone get heating in their home! Note: For manufactured and mobile home projects, only the following is eligible: exterior doors, gutters, yard cleanup, junk removal, exterior painting, walkways, driveways, steps, ramps, porches, decks, and retaining walls.



We offer home repair and preservation services to homeowners so Oregonians can continue to live in safe, decent homes for years to come. Qualifying homes are within Linn County in these ZIP codes: 97355, 97327, 97386, 97345, and 97329. This program can help revitalize neighborhoods, increase opportunities for homeowners to remain in their homes, and preserve affordable housing inventory.
